Expectations	Full and active participation in the school's musical activities as recommended by the Director of Music.
Requirements	<p>A set piece on main instrument, together with an own choice piece. All applicants must have at least passed the Grade 5 with Merit (or equivalent) examination by the closing date for applications. A copy of the relevant certificate or documentation should be attached to this application form.</p> <p>The set piece will be specified in the first week of December 2009. A second instrument (which may be Voice) is desirable. The audition will include sight-reading, scales and aural tests (Grade 5 standard) and a short interview.</p>
