Dear Year 13 Girls and Parents

As I write the Sixth Form centre is much quieter than usual and there is a sense of anticipation as the **AS level resits** and **A2 level** module examinations begin on **Wednesday 11 January**, alongside the **internal mock examinations**. Girls will be on study leave for the next two weeks, with lessons resuming on **Monday 30 January**. The beginning of the term also coincides with further news of UCAS offers and interviews, so the Spring Term promises to be an industrious one, with girls seeking to maximise their efforts.
