

CHANNING SCHOOL ANTI BULLYING STRATEGY

This needs to be read in conjunction with *The Anti Bullying Policy*, *The Behaviour Policy* and *The Channing Promise*.

The Strategy's aims are:

- 1. To provide a school environment where bullying is not tolerated and where students feel safe to tell someone if they are being bullied**
- 2. To promote an anti bullying message throughout the school and to encourage all members of the school to act with tolerance, courtesy and consideration of others at all times and to implement The Channing Promise.**

The School will work in the following ways to promote the Anti Bullying Message:

- 1. All staff praise and encourage co-operative, caring behaviour**
- 2. Staff promote positive relationships through their own behaviour**
- 3. Staff provide an environment where pupils feel accepted, valued and safe to tell a trusted adult or friend**
- 4. Staff promote the anti-bullying message**
- 5. Staff are vigilant for signs of bullying and act accordingly**
- 6. The anti bullying message is promoted in form time and assemblies and by marking Anti Bullying Week**
- 7. Specific anti bullying lessons will form part of the PSHE curriculum**
- 8. Staff remind pupils of the various sources of help and support at Channing should problems and issues arise**
- 9. Parents and pupils can raise concerns which are dealt with quickly and effectively**
- 10. Serious incidents of bullying are logged**
