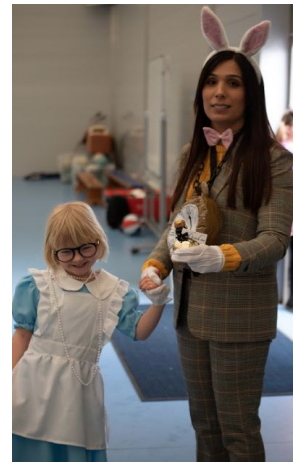


Dear Parents
