



Channing Music programme for Autumn Term 2020

Due to the COVID restrictions our usual extensive and varied programme of performances have had to be significantly altered for this year. The following outlines the plans (always subject to last minute alteration) that we have in place for the Autumn Term.

Our weekly series of Music at Lunchtime events will continue but at 3.30pm on Fridays in the Arundel Centre and will be temporarily renamed 'Music at Teatime'. We will continue to record these and upload the audio to Channing Soundcloud.

We have three concerts planned in the Arundel Centre this term. Unfortunately we cannot allow audiences into these events and so they will be videoed and released the following day online for parents, friends and staff to watch in the comfort of their own homes!

Thursday 1st October - 6.30pm - Arundel Centre -Year 11 Concert

Thursday 5th November at 6.30pm - Arundel Centre - Year 10 Concert

Both of these events will feature a number of our talented musicians from years 10 and 11 performing solos on their instruments with the added pleasure of the Year 11 Medley created and performed by this group.

Thursday 19th November at 6.30pm - Arundel Centre - Autumn Concert

Whilst not the grandiose affair that we usually hold at St Joseph's Church, we will be featuring our newly created smaller year group ensembles performing on the stage of the AC.

Finally this term we will be filming our Carol Concert which will be held at St Michael's on Monday 14th December for the Senior School. Small year group choirs plus Chamber Choir and Show Choir will be placed around the church and there will be a small representative selection of pupils and staff from the school. The event will be filmed and released online to the school and parents later.

Weekly Co-curricular Music Activities

Due to government restrictions of keeping groups in 'bubbles' and limited to only 15 members we have completely changed our co-curricular structure for this year. Each year group will have an instrumental ensemble and a vocal ensemble. We hope that all of the instrumental ensembles will be able to perform in the Autumn Concert or in one of the Music at Teatime events. Additionally we hope that all of our Vocal ensembles will perform at the Carol Concert or on one of our Music at Teatime events.
