For example; Olympia - the site and temple is covered in GCSE CC; Athens - theatre of Dionysos and Acropolis are covered in A Level and GCSE CC; Mycenae and Tiryns - major focus of the GCSE CC syllabus. Artefacts - Mycenaean artefacts in the National Archaeological Museum in Athens. These are covered in the GCSE CC, such as the Mask of Agamemnon and the Lion Hunt Dagger.
